ABSTRACT

A general account of the scope and aims of the mesometeorological network of eight stations at the ASRCT Sakaerat Experiment Station is given in Report No. 5 on Research Project 27/1.

Sakaerat Experiment Station is located at approximately latitude 14°30' N and longitude 101°55' E.

A change in nomenclature has been adopted and the stations have been numbered serially from I to 8, as set out below:
