‘No receiving of gifts and presents in all their forms on the duties in fiscal year 2025’ Policy
(No Gift Policy)

Thailand Institute of Scientific and Technological Research (TISTR) set a policy in accordance with the Constitutional Act on the Corruption Prevention and Suppression B.E. 2018, Section 128 ‘government officers shall not receive any property or benefit that can be calculated into monetary terms from others, except any property or benefit shall be received by laws, rules or regulations issued by the virtue of the provisions of the law, and unless receiving of property or benefit by ethic or criteria set by the National Anti-Corruption Commission (NACC).

To express the intention of anti-corruption and anti-misconduct in all their forms, and to promote morality, ethics and honesty in the duties of TISTR executives, employees and staff, which will result in transparency in organizational operations under the principles of good governance, we hereby express our commitment to do not receive any gifts and presents on our duties (No Gift Policy) and strictly adhere to the following practices:

- Do not seek to obtain gifts, presents, or any other unlawful benefits.
- Do not receive gifts and presents in all their forms before/during/after performing duties, which will result in corruption and misconduct, both now and in the future.
